On Saturday, March 26, 2016, the Mayor's Office on African Affairs (MOAA) in partnership with the Office of the Chief Technology Officer (OCTO), the Department of Human Resources (DCHR)'s Center for Learning and Development, and Coders4Africa (C4A), hosted a graduation ceremony for its EKO | African Diaspora Coding Academy Session II.
